

Year 7-10 Good Standing 2023

1. Rationale

It is the role of the Good Standing, within the context of Baldivis Secondary College, to clearly set and coordinate a standard of student performance across the college. This assists the student in becoming a well-rounded positive member of the college community.

Baldivis Secondary College operates on the belief, that the individuals in our community should have every opportunity extended to them, to assist them to ***“be the best that they can be.”***

This Year 7-10 Good Standing 2023 document outlines the college standards for Attendance, Commitment and Conduct that are considered necessary to meet the requirements important to Baldivis Secondary College. Good Standing provides an overall standard against which all student performance will be assessed.

The degree to which each student achieves the standards will help determine their *‘Standing’*. Students will be identified as falling into one of two groups relating to achievement against each of the standards set.

The two performance groups are:

1. **Good Standing**
2. **Conditional Good Standing**

2.0 Student Standing

2.1 Good Standing

Students who are maintain their Good Standing will have achieved the following levels of performance;

Expected Behaviour	Good Standing Expectation
Wear the full college uniform every day	In full college uniform every day. Has less than two uniform violations
Arrive to school on time	Arrives on time to school each day. Has less than two lates
Arrive to class on time	Arrives to every class on time. Has less than two lates to class
Attend every day	Student maintains a 90% attendance rate
Appropriate conduct	Students will demonstrate appropriate conduct

2.2 Conditional Good Standing

Students will be placed on conditional good standing if they do not meet the good standing expectation. The table below shows the point at which the student is placed on conditional good standing, as well as the requirement to regain good standing.

Expected Behaviour	Good Standing Expectation	Point at which student is placed on Conditional Standing	Requirements to regain Good Standing
Wear the full college uniform every day	In full college uniform every day. Has less than two uniform violations	Third and all subsequent occasions	Student adheres to college dress code for four weeks
Arrive to school on time	Arrives on time to school each day. Has less than two lates	Third and all subsequent occasions (without valid reason)	Student arrives to school on time for four weeks following conditional good standing placement
Arrive to class on time	Arrives to every class on time. Has less than two lates to class	Third and all subsequent occasions	Student arrives to each class on time for four weeks following conditional good standing placement
Attend every day	Student maintains a 90% attendance rate	Attendance drops below 90%	All absences are satisfactorily explained by a parent/carer. Student attendance rate is 90% or better for four weeks following conditional good standing placement
Appropriate conduct	Students will demonstrate appropriate conduct	First and all subsequent suspensions First and all subsequent serious breaches	Students have the opportunity to reclaim good standing within the five week period by meeting with the principal and provided evidence of having demonstrated appropriate conduct since the date of suspension/serious breach

In these circumstances, Baldivis Secondary College will undertake a number of intervention strategies. This would be in collaboration with the student, their parents, the relevant Deputy Principal, Student Services Manager and Year Coordinator. Other professionals as deemed appropriate, may also support an improvement to an acceptable level of performance against the standards.

Students on Conditional Good Standing may also lose the privilege to become involved in 2023 Good Standing activities- see table 3.
