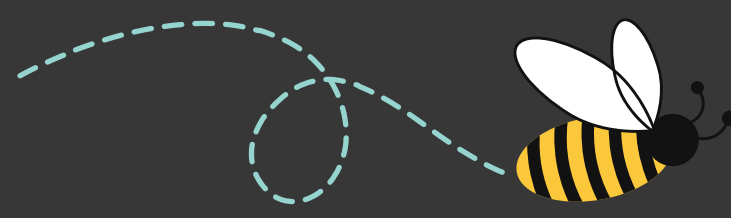


Editorial Team

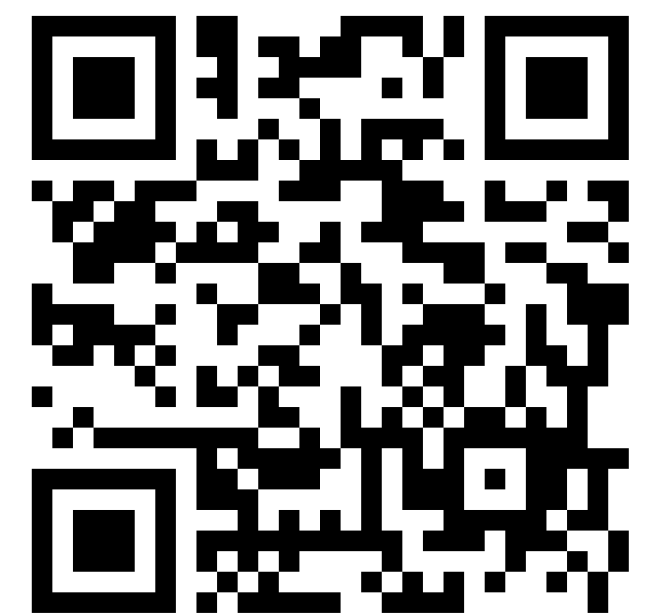

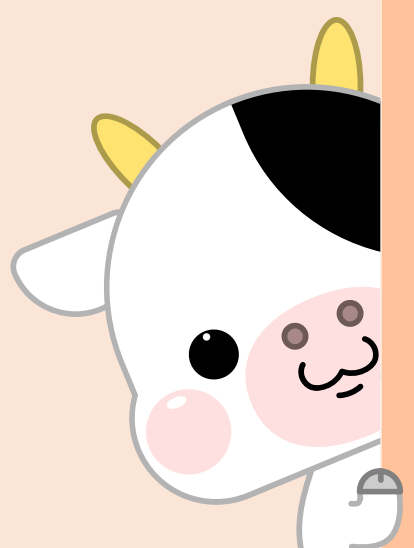


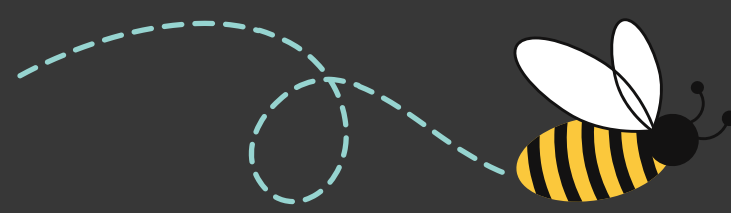
To maintain a safe and productive environment, we kindly remind students that the bathrooms should only be used when you have an 'Out of Class Pass' assigned from your teacher.

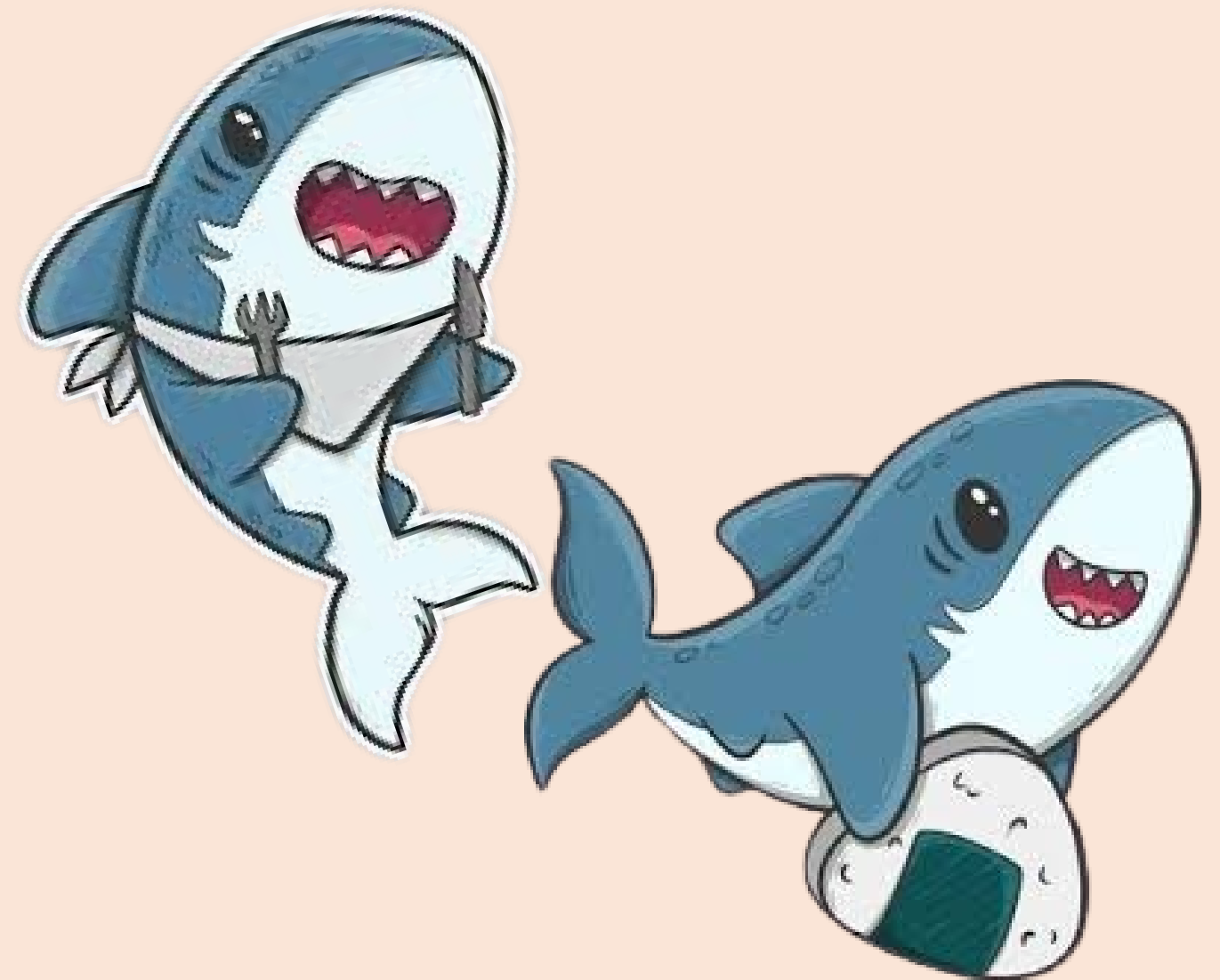

YouthCARE Poster Competition Winner!!

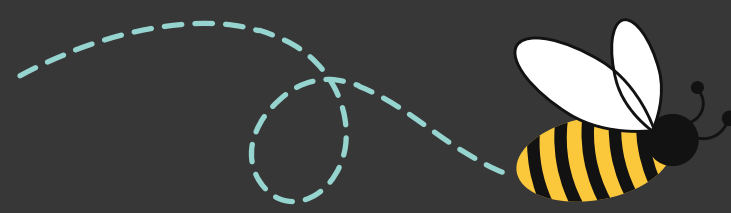
A huge congratulations to Li Qi (Year 9) on winning the 2024 YouthCARE Poster Competition with her exceptional artwork, entitled TRUTH.
