Introduction:

We would like to be able to contact your child's current school and any other agencies that have been assisting you and your child. We want to make sure that we make the transition to the Specialised Learning Program – Autism (SLP-A) as smooth as possible for your child.

This information will be used and shared with the SLP-A team and other appropriate agencies as necessary to assess, support, and enhance your child's educational outcomes and will include sharing digital work records and samples, which may contain photos. The ongoing exchange of information will continue while your child is being assessed for enrolment in the Autism Specialised Learning Program.

Observations:

As part of the selection process, SLP-A staff will contact your child's current school, and arrange to observe your child in their current school. To enable panel members to assess the support needs of your child it is important that your child **IS NOT** aware that they are being observed.

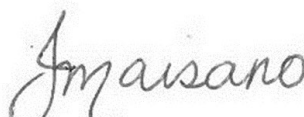
In the event that your child is not present on the selected observation day, arrangements will be made with your child's school to re-schedule the observation.
